

Drinking Water Policy

MTD recognises and accepts its responsibility towards all consumers of wholesome (drinking) water from our temporary infrastructures. Temporary infrastructures include events, flex projects and expo's. MTD acknowledges both international, national and local rules and regulation with regard to wholesome water. The management of MTD agrees that the prime responsibility of our company is to deliver drinking water to the consumers.

Potable water of a good quality is vital to each project. Being able to deliver potable water is MTD's unique selling point but it's also MTD's biggest risk. It is the aim of MTD to take all reasonably practicable steps to provide wholesome water on all points where water is to be consumed from our installations. The management has determined the following to be the most important aspects:

- Always being able to prove, with samples and monitoring, that water transported through our potable water system is within (inter)national rules and regulations.
- Train all MTD employees to be experts in potable water.
- Having a thorough risks assessment for each project.
- Wholesome water being part of the project related RAMS.
- Only using equipment certified for potable water.
- Applying disinfection to the buffers, appendages and main infrastructure.
- Actively controlling the temperature of the water.
- Separating waste and potable water equipment during transport, storage build-up and breakdown of the equipment.
- Keeping good physical hygiene throughout the work.
- Keeping track of wholesome water related KPI's and gathering water quality related data.
- Internal auditing water quality related processes and procedures.
- Being a water partner for the client.

As Water Provider we recognize that people consume the potable water and that we are therefore responsible for their health. MTD plays an important role in upkeeping the reputation for our clients. The end consumers need to be able to trust the potable water from tap points or from kitchens.

MTD wants to make sure that all issues or non-conformities with regard to wholesome water are handled with the highest priority. It is a subject we are able to talk about freely and is part of all operational MTD procedures.
